## Growing Financial Viability

### Planting seeds of financial support for pastors and congregations through a 3E Lilly Grant match of \$150,000

Funds raised will be used to match the Lilly 3E \$150,000 grant dollar-for-dollar to provide a total of \$300,000 for the Grand Canyon Synod.

The program, titled Educate, Equip, Enact (3E), will increase capacity for healthy ministry by alleviating rostered ministers' crippling debt and give tools to congregations to increase generosity and renew focus on mission.

In the Grand Canyon Synod, 3E has three components:

- Stewardship for All Seasons,
- the Ministerial Excellence Fund for rostered ministers and candidates, and
- Vital Right-Shaped Ministries.

## Growing Future Ministries

Planting seeds for Lutheran Campus Ministry (\$100,000) and new & emerging ministries (\$150,000)

#### **CAMPUS MINISTRY FUNDING**

\$50,000 for University of Arizona Campus ministry to sustain the Lutheran presence on the campus in collaboration with Presbyterian, Methodist, and Episcopal partners.

\$50,000 will be allocated to explore and potentially launch a Lutheran Campus Ministry program in the Las Vegas area in collaboration with GCS Las Vegas congregations.

#### NEW AND EMERGING MINISTRIES

Emerging ministries need additional support for a longer period of time than the initial funding sources allowed. New ministry funding will provide grants to those making proposals that offer possibilities for new ministry collaborations between congregations and/or other ministry entities.

### Growing Fervent Voices

Planting seeds for Lutheran Advocacy Ministry Arizona (\$70,000) and Lutheran Engagement & Advocacy in Nevada (\$30,000)
