

Check out our library. We have books for all ages. Here are a few kids books we have.





The Page Turner's Book Club invites you to participate in one of our lively discussions. We meet in the campus center library at 12 noon on the first Thursday of each month during the academic year. In order to expand our scope, we alternate fiction and nonfiction. Bring your lunch if you like and join us, for one book discussion or several.

February 1, 2024: "The Country of the Blind: A Memoir at the End of Sight" by Andrew Leland (2023) We meet Andrew Leland as he is mid-way through his life with retinitis pigmentosa, a condition that Leland has learned to live with. It is a condition which goes from sighted to blindness, often over decades. This story is an extremely personal and intellectual tour of a way of being that most have never experienced, and from which we have much to learn. ~ Jean Park

March 7, 2024: "The Storyteller: A Novel" by Jodi Picoult (2013) Sage Singer is a young baker trying to escape loneliness and bad memories following her mother's death. In her grief support group, Sage meets Josef Weber, an elderly man with a dark secret. They perceive each other's hidden scars and become close friends. But everything changes when Josef confesses a shameful secret and asks Sage for an extraordinary favor. How far will we go to protect our families and keep the past from dictating the future? Where do we draw the line between punishment and justice, forgiveness and mercy? "The Storyteller" uses Josef and Sage's family stories and the power of storytelling to delve into themes of guilt, for-giveness, and the complexities of human nature. ~Kim Savage






In December, we had a toy drive for our monthly stewardship project. Thank you to all who brought toys—we were able to donate a bin of toys. Thank you for your generosity.


Talk personally to these young people about what this opportunity will mean for their faith, identity, career and understanding of God's work in the world.
