


CHOIR

Thank you to Autumn Byars and Ruth Wootten for their hard work on this project.




ULC YOUNG ADULTS


PAGE TURNER'S BOOK CLUB


We finish this academic year with the following selection:

September 5th book selection


INTERIM PASTOR'S OFFICE HOURS
